CLOSED EVENT - COMPETITORS MUST LIVE OR ATTEND SCHOOL/COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY IN A LONDON BOROUGH

Eligibility:

This is a Level 2 Development event and players must live or attend a school, college or university in a London Borough. The event is limited to Juniors Novice to 6th Mon and Seniors Novice to 2nd Kyu (generally low level competitors). Technical restrictions will apply in all groups.

Competitors who have won a medal in an Area Ranking Championships are not eligible for this event. EXCEPTION: Any player who has won less than two contests at an event IS eligible.

All players must have been graded within the last 12 months (13 March 2015 to 12 March 2016). Please ensure that record books have been updated accordingly. Competitors MUST produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book when booking in, failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.

NO VALID LICENCE - NO CONTEST – NO EXCEPTIONS

Format:

Players In Group 1-4 will be grouped into pools of 4/5 players of their weight, where possible, based on the age/grade groups below. However some groups may need to be merged, and in these instances we will discuss with the coaches of the affected players. It is imperative that you put players EXACT weight on the entry form prior to the event. Please ensure there is a contact email address for any queries to be resolved prior to the event.

Players In Group 5-8 and all Senior Groups will fight in their weight groups and will receive medals for these groups, the tournament director reserves the right to combine or alter weight categories should entries dictate. In the event of any dispute the decision of the tournament director will be final

White Judogi only. Competitors are not allowed to change anywhere other than in changing rooms.

Medals will be presented after each Group, where possible.

If a player is graded and this grading leads to a change in the players colour of belt, you must inform the competition organizer in writing before the day as this can change group sizes and could mean a change of weigh in time for the player.

Girls:

Group 7 Yellow Belt 8-11 Years Old: u25kg, u28kg, u32kg, u36kg, u40kg, u44kg, u48kg, and over 48kg

Group 8 Yellow Belt 12-15 Years old: u32kg, u36kg, u40kg, u44kg, u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg, and over 63kg

Seniors:

Senior Men Group A and B: u60kg, u66kg, u73kg, u81kg, u90kg, and over 90kg

Senior Women Group C and D: u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg, u70kg, and over 70kg

Contest Times:

Junior Red Belt groups: 2 minutes duration, golden score maximum 1 minutes

Junior Yellow Belt groups: 3 minutes duration, golden score unlimited

Senior groups: 4 minutes duration, golden score unlimited

Weigh- in:

All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and females a t-shirt. Male competitors will receive a 0.5kg allowance, and female competitors a 0.6kg allowance. Senior Men will receive a 0.8kg allowance and senior women a 0.9kg allowance.
